Sixth Grade Supply List

- **2 inch** 3 ring binder- any color (Sturdy! This will be your child's homework binder all year.)
- 12" ruler (inches and centimeters, hole punched to snap in homework binder)
- zippered pencil pouch for binder (good quality- not thin plastic, needs to last all year)
- **8** sturdy subject dividers (1 set)
- college-ruled notebook paper (lots)
- 1 package 4x4 graph paper
- index cards (one package, lined or blank, 4x6 preferred, but 3x5 will work, any color)
- mechanical pencils (lots)
- erasers
- colored pencils (box of 12)
- pencil sharpener
- pens-blue or black – at least 8 red
- highlighters (2 packs of three or four, variety of colors)
- Crayola or similar thin, fine line markers (set of 10)
- 2 scissors
- 4 glue sticks
- 2 mini staplers with 2 packs of staples
- calculator (does not have to be scientific)
- 2 clipboards 9x12 (cheap Dollar Tree is fine)
- 2 wired earbuds for Chromebooks (Dollar Tree has lots)
- 1 container of bleach wipes (boys only)
- 1 box tissues (girls only)
- checkbook cover (like you would get for a bank checking account)
- checking account register (same)
- 4 stacking boxes for supplies in classrooms. Each box measures approximately 4x8 inches. Color does not matter. Last year they were sold at Fred Meyer, Walmart, and Office Depot. Please buy these ones specifically for our limited space, not other pencil boxes.
