BIBLE:

- 1 three-ring binder (7th only)
- Fine point blue or black writing pen

MATH & SCIENCE:

- calculator: it's recommended to invest in a scientific calculator
- two 1", 3-ring, solid-color binders (must have outside open-top cover for insertion of printed material)
- 12-inch ruler with metric
- Protractor (metal preferred)
- 2 quad-ruled (graph paper) composition books (not spiral)
- Pack of assorted highlighters
- colored thin-lined felt tip pens and/or colored pencils
- 100 sheets of standard notebook paper, **college ruled reinforced** (for math notebooks)
- Mead Five Star Reinforced Graph Filler Paper 100 sheets (3 packs)
- two sets of 8 notebook subject dividers with clear, rip-proof tabs (To be labeled in class)

HISTORY, ENGLISH & LITERATURE:

- Three 1", 3-ring, solid-color binders (*must have clear view cover for visible insertion of printed material*) ([Example](#))
- Three sets of eight solid color plastic dividers for 3 ring binders with label tabs (to be labeled in class) ([Example](#))
- One spiral notebook, college ruled, 8-½" x 11" sized paper ([Example](#))
- Colored pencils
- Pack of highlighters - yellow, blue, green, purple, and orange are needed ([Example](#))
- **8th grade only:** One 1.5", 3-ring, solid white binder (*must have clear view cover for visible insertion of printed material*)
- **8th grade only:** One composition notebook - must be blank at start of school year ([Example](#))

HOMEROOM:

- 1 box of tissues
- 1 box of disinfectant wipes (clorox, etc.)

ALL:

- 250 sheets of standard notebook paper, **college ruled** (may need more as year progresses)
- supply of #2 pencils or two 7 mm mechanical pencils
- supply of ballpoint pens: black or blue
- combination lock (no laser locks please)
- scissors
- 3-ring binder pouch for class use
- locker organizer
